

Landowner & Citizen Duties

In Idaho, landowners have a legal duty to control [noxious weeds](#) on their property through prevention, eradication, rehabilitation, or containment, covering associated costs. Failure to comply after a five-day county notice allows the county to manage the weeds and bill the landowner for expenses. Landowners should contact their [County Weed Superintendent](#) for identification and management help.
